Weather is:
the conditions in the air at a particular time, such as wind, rain, or temperature

Season is:
one of the four parts a year is divided into; **spring**, **summer**, **fall**, or **winter**.

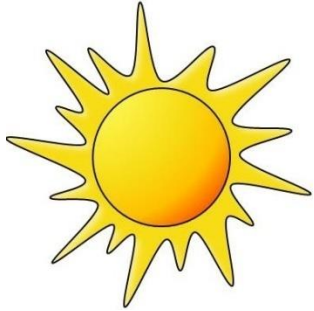

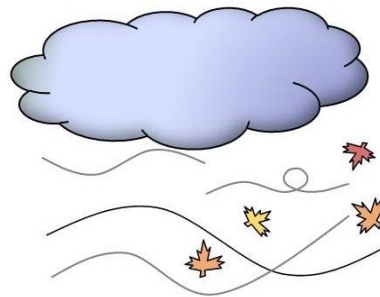

Grammar – Talk about weather



People commonly ask about the weather by saying:

What's it like out(side)?

How's the weather?

What's the weather like?

What's the temperature?

What's the weather forecast?

In English, we usually use *it is* when we talk about the weather.

We can also say:

It is + adjective = A description of the weather

It is sunny today.

It's hot and humid today.

It's a nice day today.

It is a + adjective + day (or morning/afternoon/night)

It's a fine day.

It's a windy afternoon.

It is + verb-ing = This type of weather is happening now.

It's snowing.

Take an umbrella, **it's** raining.
