MODAL VERB	USE	EXAMPLE SENTENCE
CAN	Informal. Can is used with any subject to ask for permission.	Can you call back later? I'm busy now.
COULD	Formal. Could is used with any subject to ask for permission.	Could I use your phone?
MAY	Formal. Could is used with only with the subject I. May followed by you does not express a request; it expresses a wish, as in "May you live long."	May I have this dance?




