**Angela:** Actually. She's the manager.

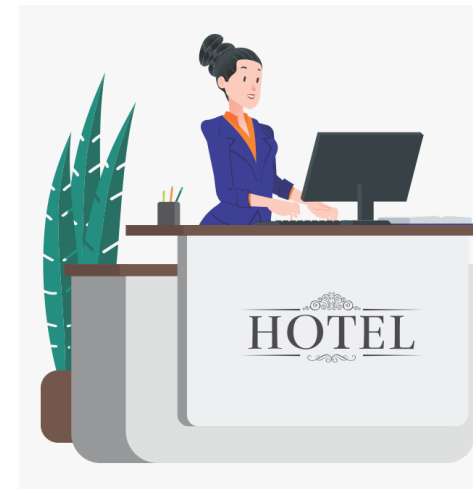

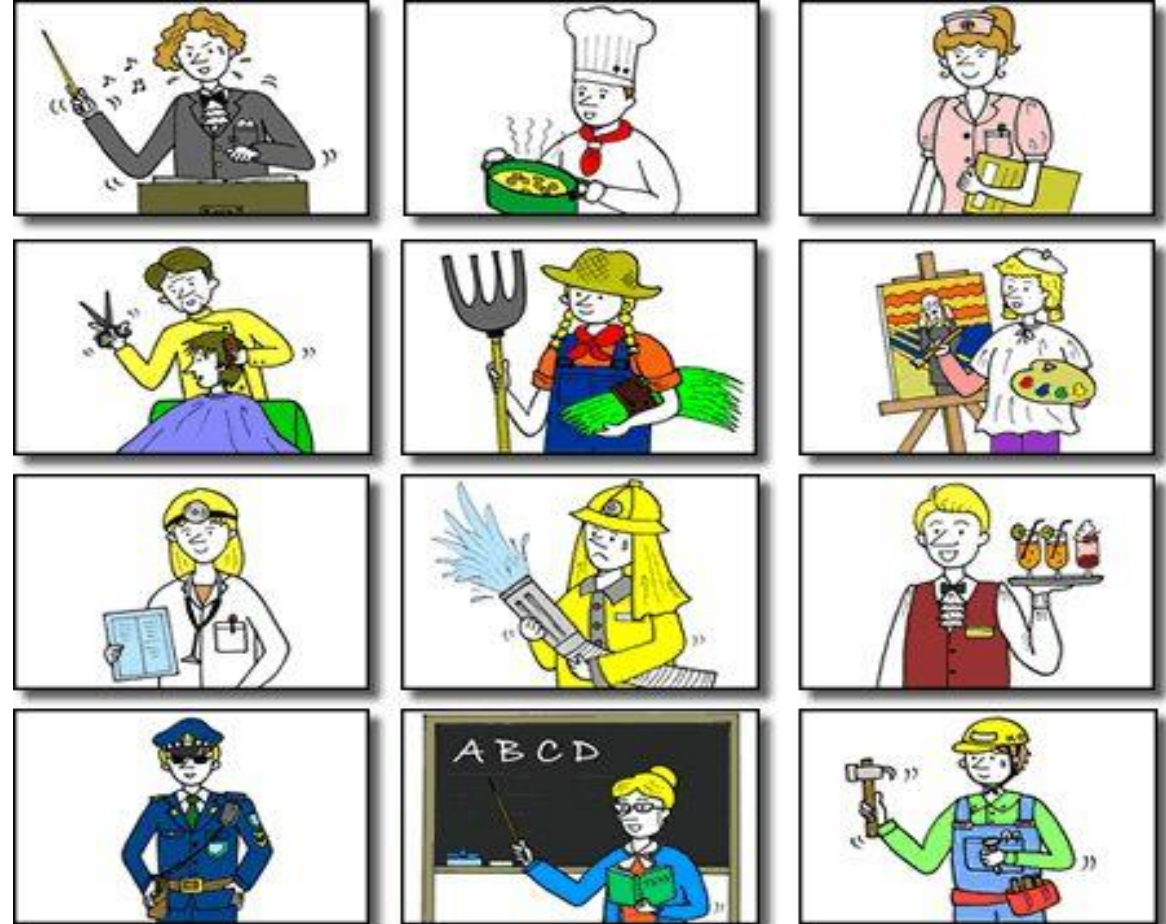
# Role Playing
