Physical Appearance is the way that someone looks.

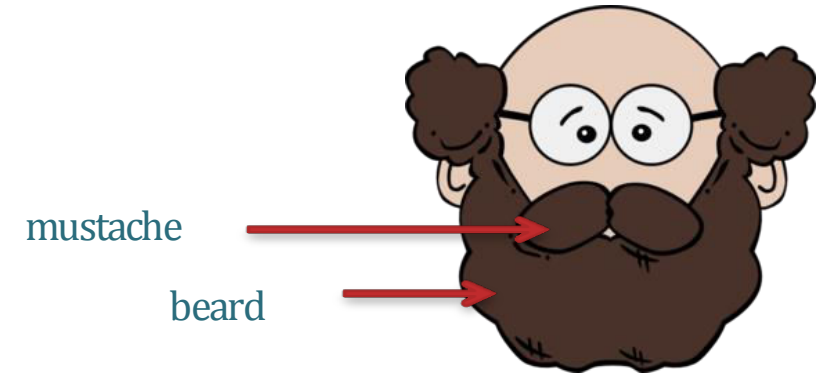
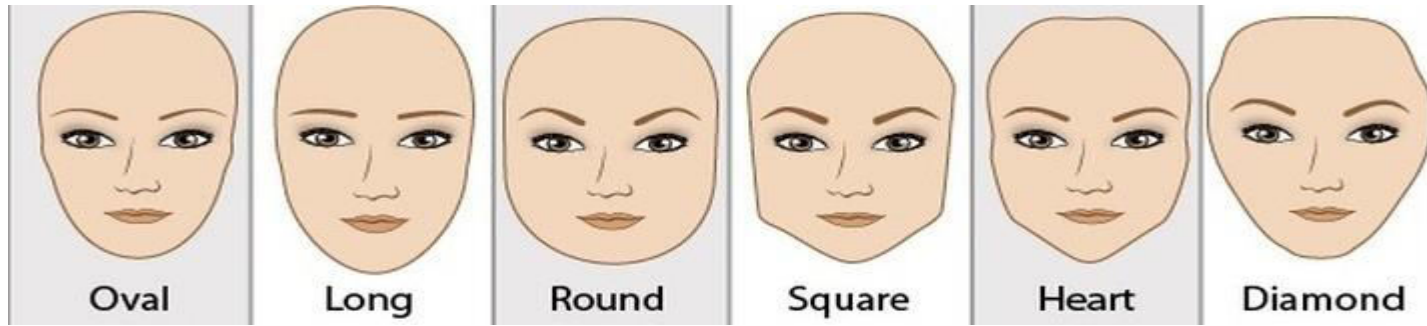
We are all different. Some are young and some are old. Some are tall and some are short. No two people are exactly the same. We're all different in our own ways.

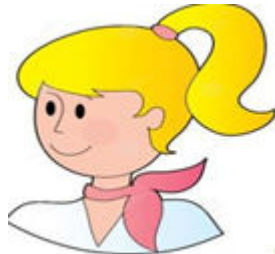

Noun (subject) + verb + comparative adjective + *than* + noun (object).

Examples:

- Ben is **taller** than John.



- Tom has **longer** hair than Jim.

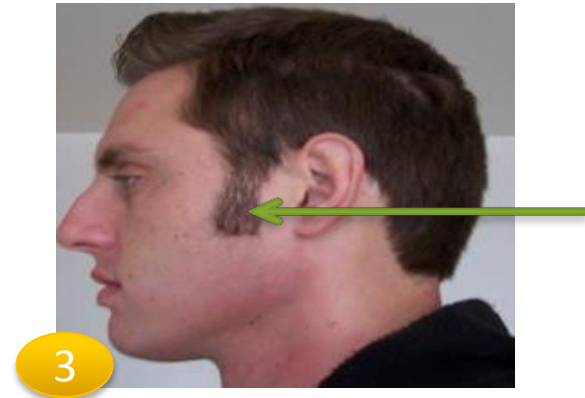
