

Female MECHANIC

Nikki Evans is a car mechanic in London. She used to be a librarian. We asked her why she decided to work in cars. "My first reason was independence", she said. "I also wanted to use my hands, and I like to learn how things work. Besides, I came to the conclusion that many people prefer to have a woman repair their cars.

Nikki didn't find it easy to become a car mechanic. She had to attend a Skills Center – a special sort of college where people can learn a new job – for twenty weeks. She tells us about it.



"For ten weeks I was the only woman among four hundred men. And some of them were rude to me just because of my sex. It was also very tiring: from eight in the morning to five in the evening, with only thirty minutes lunch."

Now Nikki works freelance – that is, she is self employed, working for herself and not for a garage or a company.
