- **OUTDOOR**
= activities done outside

| % | Adverbs of Frequency | Example Sentences: |
|------|----------------------|---------------------------------|
| 100% | Always | I always study after class. |
| 90% | Usually | I usually walk to work |
| 70% | Often | I often read in bed at night. |
| 50% | Sometimes | I sometimes sing in the shower. |
| 0% | Never | Vegans never eat meat. |

Subject + Adverb + Main Verb

Daniel always plays the guitar.

Subject + Be verb + Adverb

Daniel is always happy.

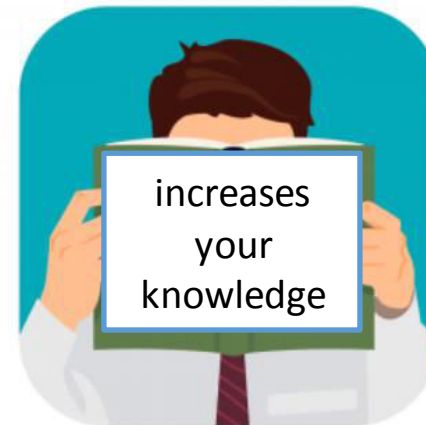
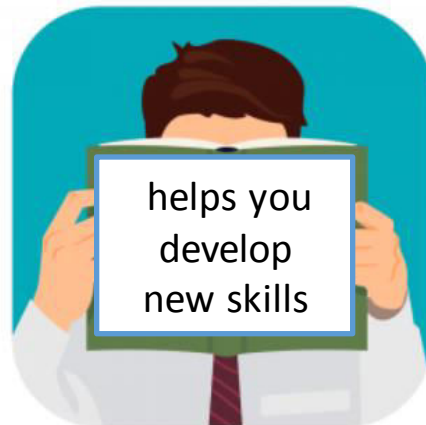
