# Seasons of the Sun

Adverbs of Degree	Example sentences
extremely	The water was <i>extremely</i> cold.
quite	Snow is <i>quite</i> interesting.
just	He was <i>just</i> leaving.
almost	It's <i>almost</i> summer next week.
very	The days are <i>very</i> fast.
too	Time moves <i>too</i> slowly when you're busy.
enough	Please turn off the heater. It's enough warm <i>enough</i> .

Adverbs of degree are usually placed **before** the adjective, adverb, or verb that they modify.
