Test Tip

Listening for SVO words

Most distractors in TOEIC Part 1 questions follow a subject, verb, object pattern (SVO). Listen carefully for SVO words and compare the words you hear to what is in the picture.

Listen for wrong main subject, verb and object


Some distractors use correct key words and incorrect ones. If you hear an incorrect one you can immediately ignore that answer choice.






O Learn by doing: Three in a row game
