## Summer program refund policy

The effective of the withdrawal/cancellation is the date the withdraw notice is received by the center, regardless of the date the participant stopped attending the class.

Withdrawal requests from all registered courses must be made before the second class is held. If the request is received 5 business days prior to the first class, the amount refunded will be the full amount, les the refund administration fee ( $\$ 25.00$ ). If the request is received after the first class, but before the second class, the amount refunded will be the full amount, less the cost of the first class and less the administration fee ( $\$ 25.00$ ). From the second lesson onwards, no refunds/credits will be issued.

If there is a medical reason for the request, a doctor's note must be received prior to the mid-point of the program. Refunds for sports and fitness programs will NOT be processed until ALL gym and pool passes have been returned.
